## CALL 911 when . . .

any of the following occur:

- someone passed out **cannot be roused** with shouting or vigorous shaking or cannot be roused for more than **2-3 minutes** at a time
- there is slow or irregular **breathing**, or a lapse in breathing
- **pulse** is weak, very rapid, or very slow
- **skin** is cold, clammy, or bluish
- someone **vomits** while passed out, does not wake up after vomiting, or is incoherent while vomiting

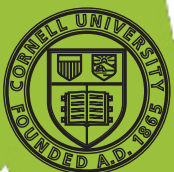
