

HIV Testing

Gannett offers two (2) options for HIV testing. Both options are **private** and **confidential**, and both require a **follow-up appointment** for results.

BLOOD TEST: (99.99% accurate)

A blood sample is drawn and sent to an outside lab for testing. Results come back in 3-5 business days. \$25*

ORAL TEST: (99.96% accurate)

An oral swab will be taken and sent to an outside lab for testing. Results come back one week later. This is an especially good method for people who don't like needles. \$45*

APPOINTMENTS: Please call 255-5155 to schedule an appointment for HIV testing. Or, if you are making an appointment at Gannett for another medical reason, consider asking if it is possible for you to test for HIV at the time of your visit.

NOTE: All HIV testing is most reliable three months after exposure. All test options at Gannett utilize both the Eliza and Western Blot method.

Anonymous rapid HIV testing is available off-campus through the Tompkins County Department of Health. Call 274-6683 for more information.
